(Uncle Mo - Arealhotlover, by Untuttable) 2013 Bay Horse Record: 12-2-1-2 (\$224,500)

Section I: STALLION AND IMMEDIATE FAMILY

Uncle Vinny brings precocious speed and class to the Florida market. He is the only son of the Champion Freshman Sire Uncle Mo, to stand in Florida. Uncle Mo sired a remarkable record-breaking 25 stakes winners in his first crop and is poised to become a sire of sires.

Uncle Vinny was bred by long-time Florida horseman Gilbert G. Campbell and was an exciting member of Uncle Mo's first crop, selling at the Keeneland September auction for \$175,000, well above his sire's yearling average. The bay colt campaigned in Starlight Racing silks under the tutelage of Hall of Fame trainer Todd Pletcher.

Sent off as the favorite in his May debut at Belmont Park, Uncle Vinny dazzled by 4 1/2 lengths in :58.70.

Next out, Uncle Vinny placed sixth in the 5 1/2 furlong Tremont Stakes, after being slammed between opponents and having to check sharply on the backstretch, losing position.

Uncle Vinny captured the Sanford Stakes (G3) in his next outing, defeating eventual Iroquois Stakes (G3) winner Cocked and Loaded. Uncle Vinny placed third in the Hopeful (G1) after a wide trip.

As a three-year-old, Uncle Vinny was second in an allowance race then placed third in the 1 1/16 mile Long Branch Stakes. Cutting back in distance in the Amsterdam Stakes (G2), Uncle Vinny had a wide trip at the back of the pack and improved to fourth place. He retired with a 12-2-1-2- (\$224,500) record.

SIRE LINE

Uncle Vinny continues the very important sire line of Caro. Imported by Spendthrift Farm in 1997, Caro spent a decade as a successful sire and damsire. His daughter Winning Colors was only the third filly to win the Kentucky Derby (G1). During his ten year tenure at Spendthrift, other notable sons and daughters include 1989 Canadian Triple Crown winner With Approval, 1985 Champion Turf Male Cozzene, multiple Grade I winner Dr. Carter, 1991 Irish Champion Stayer Turgeon, and 1990 Arlington Million (G1) winner Golden Pheasant. He also sired Trolley Song, dam of multiple Grade 1 winner and successful sire Unbridled's Song.

Uncle Vinny is a direct descendant of Caro through the longest branch of Caro's male line, that of **Siberian Express**. The best son produced by Siberian Express was the Irish-bred **In Excess**, who was a multiple Grade 1 winning handicap horse in the U.S. In Excess became a cornerstone of the modern breeding program in California.

In Excess' most accomplished son on and off the track was **Indian Charlie**. Under the care of Hall of Fame trainer Bob Baffert, Indian Charlie raced only once as a two-year-old but accomplished much in his short career at three. The very talented Indian Charlie captured two allowance races before a 2 1/4 length triumph in the Santa Anita Derby (G1) over his stablemate and eventual Kentucky Derby (G1) winner **Real Quiet**. Indian Charlie was in the running in the stretch of the Kentucky Derby and finished third. He was injured during a workout and retired to stud in 1999.

During his stud career, Indian Charlie was a sire of champions and was among the leading sires of his generation.

Indian Charlie's most successful son by far is **Uncle Mo**. The 2010 Champion two-year-old colt recorded the highest speed figures of his generation as a two and three-year-old. He has continued his winning ways at stud, instilling both precocious speed and classic stamina to his offspring.

DISTAFF LINE

Bred for win-early speed top and bottom, Uncle Vinny is the most gifted of a trio of blacktype earners out of the precious stakes winner and multiple stakes placed Arealhotlover. His dam is the most accomplished producer in three generations of the distaff line and was her sire's third-highest earner on the track in 2007.

Uncle Vinny's half-sister **Legal Laura** (Wildcat Heir) captured the **Millions Distaff Preview S. (R)** at seven furlongs by 2 1/2 lengths. The mare is also multiple stakes placed at Gulfstream Park, Tampa, and Monmouth. She earned \$217,450 in an 18-race career.

Uncle Vinny's other blacktype earning half-sister **LuLu Laura** (Circular Quay) was a precocious youngster and placed second in the 2016 **Florida Sire Desert Vixen S. (R)**. She earned over \$100,000 in 11 starts.

Arealhotlover (Untuttable - Hot Rod Helen, by Regal Search) won or placed in ten of 16 starts over a three-year career and earned \$146,567. A win-early two-year-old, the Gilbert Campbell homebred was third, beaten a neck for second in the six-furlong J J'Sdream Stakes (L). She returned to finish second, 5 1/4 lengths to the good, in the restricted GTOBA Juvenile Filly Turf Dash Stakes (R) at Calder. After a fourth-place finish in the Florida Stallion Susan's Girl Stakes (R), Arealhotlover broke through with a 2 3/4 length victory in the Cassidy Stakes, beating listed stakes winner and Grade 1 placed Yonagucci.

Arealhotlover's half-sister **Fast Lisa** (Sword Dancer) is a stakes winner and multiple stakes placed earner of \$129,320 in 15 starts. Fast Lisa bore the multiple restricted turf sprinter **Dances with Ashley** (Wildcat Heir).

Uncle Vinny's second dam **Hot Rod Helen** (Regal Search - Terrible Terri T., by Greek Answer) was in the money in six of nine starts. She is a half-sister to three stakes winners, two by the **Exclusive Native** stallion **Premiership**; Hot Rod Helen's half-sister **Pleasant Dilemma** was a multiple listed dirt sprinter who earned over \$260,000 in 35 starts. Pleasant Dilemma's full brother **Philadream** earned a stakes win as a two-year-old and was a sturdy 88-race competitor over all surfaces. Hot Rod Helen's half-sister **Lynn's a Dream**, by the **In Reality** stallion **Shananie**, was a multiple stakes winner over all surfaces, and hit the board in 24 of 42 starts, earning over \$225,000.

Uncle Vinny's third dam **Terrible Terri T.** (Greek Answer - Solono, by L'Aiglon) was an extremely precocious juvenile; She placed in the **Hialeah Sales Stakes (R)** in her April debut. After winning her maiden a month later, Terrible Terri T. was second in four straight races, including the **Astoria Stakes** at Belmont, and the **Colleen** and **Sorority Stakes (G1)** at Monmouth Park. On the board in seven of nine starts, Terrible Terri T. earned \$79,553.

Untuttable (Unbridled - Tutta, by In Reality) won or placed in three of five starts. As a broodmare sire, he got 75 foals out of 25 mares, with 4 stakes winners and two stakes placed earners. Uncle Vinny is the most accomplished of the produce. Untuttable's half-sister **Queen Tutta** (Kris S.) was a stakes winner and multiple graded placed earner of over \$293,000 in 26 starts. She was the most accomplished runner out of the unraced Tutta M, a granddaughter of the great **Gold Digger**, dam of the legendary **Mr. Prospector**.

Section II: STALLION ANCESTRY AND BREEDING PATTERNS

Uncle Vinny is <u>inbred</u> to: Mr. Prospector 4D x 5D Raise a Native 5D x 5D x 6S Gold Digger 5D x 5X

Uncle Vinny is the only one of Uncle Mo's stakes-winning offspring to have <u>Rasmussen Factor breeding</u> to <u>Gold Digger</u>. His dam Arealhotlover has 3 x 3 Rasmussen Factor breeding (inbred to a superior mare within the first five generations) to <u>Gold Digger</u> through the full siblings Gold Mine and <u>Mr. Prospector</u>.

The only other Uncle Mo stakes winner descending from Gold Digger's distaff line is San Luis Rey Handicap (G2) winner **Epical**.

Although not an RF breeding, Uncle Vinny's dam is inbred to the <u>Rene-de-Course</u> **Aspidistra** through half-siblings **Dr. Fager** and **Magic**, and carries the bloodlines of **Rough 'n Tumble**, all solid bloodlines found in many Florida-bred mares. The <u>half-siblings</u> Be Suspicious and Hail to Reason are found in the sixth generation.


Aspidistra is found in the pedigrees of **Holy Bull** and his offspring **Cairo Prince** (Pioneerof the Nile), **Nonna Mia** (Empire Maker), who bore Wood Memorial winner and new sire **Outwork** (Uncle Mo). Going back a generation, Indian Charlie's son **Conveyance** (G3 winner) is out of a Holy Bull mare.

Aspidistra is also included in the pedigree of **Quiet American**, who is found in the bloodlines of many established runners and sires, including **Bernardini**, **Wildcat Heir**, **Astrology**, **Munnings**, **Albert the Great**, **Forestry**, and **Golden Missile**.

Other Reins-de-Courses include Courtly Dee (Althea), Natalma, Bold Princess and Bramlea.


Other <u>key names</u> in the pedigree include the bloodlines of **Northern Dancer** (4D x 5D x 5S) through **Leo Castelli** (Sovereign Dancer) on the sire side, and **Dixieland Band** and **Danzig** on the distaff side. **Roberto**, and only one strain of **Bold Ruler** through a minor son, **Laiglon**, Uncle Vinny's fourth damsire.

<u>Dosage</u> is used in breeding to show the overall composition and strength of the pedigree. Uncle Vinny's five-generation dosage is heavy on Brilliant speed, with equal points of Intermediate and Classic. Although he never won beyond six furlongs, his bloodlines indicate that bred to mares with stamina, he could get winners up to middle distances in the right settings.







ASPIDISTRA (Better Self-Tilly Rose, by Bull Briar) This mare is among the newer brigade. She should be a major "blue hen" as the 21st century approaches. The dam of Dr Fager, Aspidistra showed her potential in the 1990 Kentucky Derby winner UNBRIDLED, where she was duplicated in the fourth remove, i.e. 4 x 4.

Bold Ruler 1954 1 Nasrullah 1940 Miss Disco 1944 M 8-d DKB

BOLD RULER (Nasrullah-Miss Disco, by Discovery) was typecast as a possible begetter of unsound horses because he was retired with a filled fore ankle. The "jokers reckoned" breeding back to him would be courting trouble.

Jack Werk's magazine "Owner-Breeder", which produces some statistical gems, showed that in 15 months leading up to late 1993, 41 horses linebred to Bold Ruler won North American stakesraces. the 1996 Preakness winner LOUIS QUATORZE is linebred 3 x 4 to BOLD RULER through a son/daughter

The 1996 Duke Of York St winner VENTURE CAPITALIST carried a BOLD RULER triple through two sons and a daughter.

The 2002 crack South African 3yo FLIGHT ALERT (National Assembly-Belte, by Bush Telegraph), who won the Gr I Cape Argus Gns was linbred to Bold Ruler (son and daughter) 4 x 4.

As was the Sydney Gr I Q Elizabeth Stakes winner DEFIER (Dehere-Lilande, by Marscay)

DR FAGER 1964 2 Rough 'n Tumble 1948 Aspidistra 1954 M 1-r B

Dr FAGER ,1964.. (Rough 'N Tumble--Aspidistra, by Better Self).

DR FAGER 1964 (Rough 'n Tumble-Aspidistra, by Better Self)

Was a top galloper. With his powerful personal linebreeding can do nothing but star when duplicated judiciously in planned matings. Is linebred to BULL DOG (3 X 4) and TEDDY (4 x 5 x 5) with desirable male-female balances present in each instance.

SCENIC POINT (Unbridled--Bangkok, by Riverman), who won the Princess Rooney St, was linebred to Dr Fager (twice) and his half sister Magic).

The USA stallion UNBRIDLED is inbred to Dr Fager 2 x 3. It would appear he could leave decent racehorses if he met mares with a further strain.

HAIL TO REASON 1958 2 Turn-To 1951 Nothirdchance 1948 M 4-n BR

HAIL TO REASON, 1958. (Turn -To--Nothirdchance, by Blue Swords). Features prominently as a sire of sires i e ROBERTO, BOLD REASON, HALO and company.

LUCKY ROBERTO (Belong To Me --Roberto's Girl, by Roberto), who took the Grl Saratoga Hopeful Stakes in 1998,was line bred to Hail To Reason in the third and fourth removes through male and female lines.

The swift USA juvenile EXCITING STORY (Diablo -Appealing Story, by Valid Appeal) and his Canadian Gr I winning sister DIABLO'S STORY carried Hail To Reason 4m X 4f.

The multiple stakes winner FORTITUDE (Cure The Blues--Outlasting, by Seattle Slew) was line bred to Hail To Reason in the third and fourth genrations.

The Gr I 2002 Canterbury Guineas winner in Sydney Australia Carnegie Express (Carnegie--Honeymoon Express, by Star Way) was linebred to Hail To Reason through male and female lines in the fifth remove.

Hail To Reason is relatively young in a line breeding sense and looks destined to make a major impact as time proceeds.

IN REALITY 1964 2 Intentionally 1956 My Dear Girl 1957 M 21-a B

IN REALITY 1964 (Internationally-My Dear Girl, by Rough 'nTumble). Was a small galloping wizard, who won 14 times from 27 appearances. Led the USA 2YO sire premiership in 1977.

The 1998 US champion 3YO filly BANSHEE BREEZE (Unbridled--Banshee Winds, by Known Fact) was linebred to In Reality in the third and fourth removes.

MR PROSPECTOR 1970 2 Raise A Native 1961 Gold Digger 1962 M 13-c B

MR PROSPECTOR (Raise A Native--Gold Digger, by Nashua). Has a wonderful affinity with the Northern Dancer line, the catalyst being Native Dancer carried in the cross, through a son and a daughter. His sons Down Under had the penchant to leave runners with an affinity with rain affected ground.

Very few runners appear to be line bred to Mr Prospector in a sex balanced pattern. The horse is still very much up front in pedigrees. The juvenile WAKI AMERICAN from the first crop left by Latin American was inbred to MR PROSPECTOR through male and female lines. In New Zealand the homebred horse HIS EXCELLENCY (Roughcast US- Gem in the Rough US, by Mr Prospector) has an important Mr Prospector factor.

NASHUA 1952 3 Nasrullah 1940 Segula 1942 M 3-m B

NASHUA, 1952 (Nasrullah-Segula, by Johnstown) Has the flair to upgrade pedigrees when duplicated through a son and a daughter. An important factor in the MR PROSPECTOR saga, being that great inflluence's damsire. SEGULA also left SABETTE and STAVROULA.

The TesioPower bloodline computer programs carries 38 stakeswinners line bred to NASHUA.

One was the champion USA 3YO filly HOLLYWOOD WIILDCAT with her Kris S /Mr Prospector cross. She carried NASHUA 4 x 4 through daughters.

The Argentina bred LAZY LODE (Lode-Lazy Fables, by Babas Fables), who won the Hollywood Turf Cup carried Nashua through a son and daughter in the fourth remove.

NATALMA, 1957 mare. (Native Dancer--Almahmoud, by Mahmoud). Has gained equine immortality as NORTHERN DANCER'S dam. Has left the fillies ARCTIC DANCER, SPRING ADIEU and RAISE THE STANDARD. The outstanding stallion DANEHILL is linebred to NORTHERN DANCER and SPRING ADIEU.

DANEHILL has starred with the Golden Slipper winner FLYING SPUR and the Irish Derby winner DESERT KING (Irish Dereby, 2000 Gns), both carrying a third Northern Dancer line in their dams. This represents a NATALMA triple.

Native Dancer 1950 2 Polynesian 1942 Geisha 1943 M 5-f GR

NATIVE DANCER 1950, (Polynesian-Geisha, by Discovery) is probably the most influential individual in linebreeding exercises as the 21st century approached

Statistics show that 78 per cent of runners carrying two strains or more of Native Dancer win races and 28 per cent annexe stakes races. Many of the great nicks, in particular the influential Northern Dancer-Mr Prospector and the Northern Dancer-Blushing Groom crosses have gained impetus through Native Dancer's presence, through a son and a daughter.

In early 1995 commentators drew attention to a burgeoning nick involving Danzig over Alydar mares. This had produced three Group I winners from only 12 raceday representatives. Native Dancer was the catalyst, being carried through a son and daughter in the exercise. The outstanding British middle distance star HALLING carried Native

Dancer through a son and a daughter in the fourth and sixth removes, showing he's readily available still in contemporary pedigrees. A rather controversial 1980 horse DANZATORE (Northern Dancer-Shake A Leg, by Raise A native) was purchased at considerable expense for stud duty. He was inbred to Native Dancer through male and female lines. He was later transferred to the USA winding up in Texas. However, when he was carried further back in pedigrees as a damsire his Native Dancer presences saw his fortunes soar.

The 1999 E P Taylor St winner INSIGHT (Sadler's Wells -Or Vision, by Irish River) had the male /female Native Dancer presence carried through Northern Dancer's dam NATALMA and RAISE A NATIVE in the dam.

Nearctic 1954 1 Nearco 1935 Lady Angela 1944 M 14-c BR

NEARCTIC 1954 (Nearco -Lady Angela, by Hyperion). Has made an indelible mark in breeding circles as Northern Dancer's sire. Is a powerful influence when he picks up a female line in any dam. The sire QUIET AMERICAN (Fappiano-Demure, by Dr Fager) has a female NEARCTIC presence and stars with mares carrying a NORTHERN DANCER line.

The stakes winning trio CARA RAFÁELA, QUIET DANCE and AMERICAN DYNASTY all carry this QUIET AMERICAN/ NORTHERN DANCER factor.

NORTHERN DANCER 1961 4 Nearctic 1954 Natalma 1957 M 2-d B

NORTHERN DANCER (Nearctic-Natalma, by Native Dancer). This legendary figure had a bonanza 1995 as a linebreeding presence. The Epsom Derby winner Lammtarra, who scored when beginning a new campaign, carried Northern Dancer through a son and a daughter. The English 2000 Guineas success Pennekamp boasted two male Northern Dancer lines plus Bubbling Beauty, a half sister to Northern Dancer's dam Natalma. Down Under the Sydney Golden Slipper Stakes for two-year-olds was annexed by Flying Spur, who carried Northern Dancer through a son and a daughter along with his half sister Spring Adieu. An Arrowfield Stud product, Flying Spur was by Danehill ,whose climb to stardom was boosted by the Northern Dancer /Spring Adieu duplication.

Studies by Alan Porter, an English authority working in New York, showed that Northern Dancer presences had a remarkable affinity with Teddy. Among the quality performers carrying NORTHERN DANCER through sons only, something like 78 per cent carry a male line through LYPHARD or NIJINSKY II when these two are represented through female factors. NORTHFIELDS is another in this category when the Northern Dancer circumstances are examined

This is a challenging situation for buffs to explain.

Princequillo 1940 1 Prince Rose 1928 Cosquilla 1933 M 1-b B

PRINCEQUILLO. One of the biggest and best in the linebreeding business and responsible for many Sir Tristram triumphs Down Under. A P Indy (USA), Mannerism (Australia) and Miltak (New Zealand) are all linebred to Princequillo emphasising his global influence. Is a large heart carrier and worth developing in multiples when planning matings.

A superb family upgrader readily available in male and female strains.

RAISE A NATIVE 1961 4 Native Dancer 1950 Raise You 1946 M 8-f CH

RAISE A NATIVE (Native Dancer-Raise You, by Case Ace) This fellow is now a proven name in the linebreeding firmament. Foaled in 1961, Raise A Native is now featuring far enough back in family trees to make a major impact. He's now being duplicated in the "engine room" - say within the third and fourth removes - and should have an exciting future. Four Northern Hemisphere stakeswinners were linebred to him in 1993 and this had doubled in 12 months according to statistics in the "Owner-Breeder."

In 1998 there were something like six stakeswinners a month carrying Raise A Native duplications. In October 1999 there were 10 prestige winners carrying RAISE A NATIVE doublings

Subsequently Alan Porter reported that by June 2001 182 restricted stakeswinners had been linebred to Raise A Native.







Uncle Vinny's pedigree is heavy with Mr. Prospector/Raise a Native bloodlines. I suggest breeding to mares with these bloodlines at least three or more generations back, preferably through the **Northern Afleet (Afleet Alex)**, **Gone West, Seeking the Gold** and **Rubiano** lines rather than **Unbridled**, unless Unbridled is four generations back, due to soundness concerns.

Uncle Vinny has only one strain of Northern Dancer through his distaff line, and adding more of this line, especially through **Storm Cat**, could be very successful. Uncle Mo is golden with mares from the Storm Cat line, having six blacktype earners, including Champion **Nyquist**.

Nicking reports only consider the proposed sire. The following Nicking list includes matches for both Uncle Mo and Indian Charlie since Uncle Mo is a young sire.





Note

Breed your stallion to the best available mares, especially for his first few crops. That means the best mares that you can afford, by stallions that get a high percentage of winners and stakes winners. Look for broodmare sires with an AEI higher than their CI. Conformation is as important as pedigree, so make sure the chosen mares strengths outweigh any potential conformational weaknesses the stallion may have.

Just because a sire is listed as a possible fit, doesn't mean that sire is a good broodmare sire. For instance, as a broodmare sire, Grindstone's daughters have produced just 20 stakes winners, 3% of total runners, and an AEI of 1.19.
